The figure lying on the bed represents Germany. Clemenceau was Prime Minister of France in 1919. He is shown as a vampire sucking the blood out of Germany.



Peace and future cannon fodder' - a cartoon of 1920 by the Australian artist Will Dyson. 'The Tiger' was a nickname for Clemenceau. In the caption, Clemenceau is saying: 'Curious! I seem to hear a child weeping'.
